Submission Guidelines

Compositions should be for standard Wind Quintet instrumentation: Flute (piccolo), Oboe (English Horn), Clarinet (A and Bb), Bassoon and French Horn. Works must be no more than ten minutes in duration. Interested composers should submit:

• a legible, full score and parts

- a recording of the piece on CD (if available)
- a biography, with current address, phone number and email
- · if you wish to have your music returned, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope

All entries must be postmarked no later than Thursday, November 15, 2007.
